CYBER SECURITY DELEGATION FOR GOVERNANCE & LEGAL PROFESSIONALS

CyBiz in conjunction with the Israel Trade & Economic Commission to Australia is hosting a Cyber Security Delegation to Israel for Governance and Legal Professionals from 21-25 June 2026, during the world-leading Israel Cyber Week conference in Tel Aviv.

Australian organisations have been in the news over the last 2-3 years for high profile Cyber Security breaches which have resulted in significant quantities of sensitive business and customer data being released onto the dark web. Those organisations have faced significant remediation costs, the issue has been a major distraction for boards, executives and the organisations as a whole, and has led to major reputational damage.

Both board members and legal professionals are at the forefront of Cyber Security Incident Response, managing a cyber crisis through a complex storm of operational, communications, financial, legal and technical issues.

- ASIC has put directors on notice that they will be held responsible for data breaches which arise from inadequate management of Cyber Security and failure to ensure that their businesses have undertaken comprehensive planning to prepare for significant Cyber Security Incidents.
- While data protection was once considered an IT issue, given the operational, financial and reputational risks which result from a significant Cyber Security breach, both external lawyers and in-house counsel play a key role in working with the board and advising senior management on managing Cyber Security Incidents, assisting organisations on challenging issues such as ransomware, compliance obligations, contractual obligations, regulatory requirements, and cyber insurance.



This delegation will expose you to the latest ideas, technologies and approaches to managing Cyber Security risks and responding to serious Cyber Security Incidents, whilst networking with leading international experts and like-minded professionals focusing on Cyber Security risk, governance, crisis management and incident response.

THE START-UP NATION IS A WORLD LEADER IN CYBER SECURITY

Israel is widely regarded as being a leading country in Cyber Security. This has evolved with the help of Israeli government initiatives, which have for many years actively supported the development and growth of the Cyber Security sector through investments, grants, and incentives, as is the case with other technology sectors in Israel.

In Australia, following the major Cyber Security breaches over the last 3 years, there has been greater focus on developing public-private partnerships as a cornerstone of Australia's Cyber Security strategy, whereas Israel has always used public-private partnerships to counter Cyber Security threats, facilitate information sharing, and joint initiatives.

Cyber innovation hubs form part of Israel's vibrant culture of innovation and start-up ecosystem, and co-locate academia, industry, government and to some extent the military, to foster collaboration in Cyber Security.

One of the biggest factors in Israel's Cyber Security prowess is its compulsory military service, through which the Israel Defense Forces provide extensive training in technology and Cyber Security, and which gives many individuals invaluable experience and skills that they later apply in the civilian Cyber Security sector.
